# **School Development Plan 2017-18**

We then select some key objectives to help the school to further improve. This year we are focusing on:

- -Making sure the vast majority of children achieve agerelated expectations or above. For those children who need to make rapid progress we will ensure they are supported and challenged
- -Continuing to improve the wider curriculum, ensuring that the standards we reach in English and mathematics are matched in other subjects.
- -To further improve reading provision across the school. Making sure that parents regularly read with their child and that the reading experiences available in school are enjoyable.
