Summer Holiday Activities

The holidays are fast approaching and we're sure the children and families are ready to relax and have some fun (hopefully in the sun!). If you would like to have some educational activities to do with your child to keep their learning moving forward, we've a few things you can do.

Reading

-Keep reading! It will make a huge difference to your child's attainment if they keep reading over the summer. They might want to do the [summer reading challenge](#) which starts on Saturday 3rd July in all Cheshire East libraries. The summer reading challenge is great fun, it's free and helps to combat the 'reading dip' that can happen during the summer holidays. There is a certificate and a medal for all children who read 6 library books. Your child can also let us know what books they've enjoyed over the summer by clicking on this [link](#). We'll be awarding Headteacher's awards to any children who read 6 books or more over the summer holiday.

-Children in Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 all have usernames and passwords for Reading Eggs, an app based reading programme. This will be available for them to continue using over the summer holidays.
