Our charity focus this term is the Marine Conservation Society. The children will be learning about the global impact of single use plastics on marine life and the oceans.



The teachers have planned some engaging activities based around this theme and children will be exploring ideas about how we can reduce our use of single use plastics at school and at home. We look forward to keeping parents updated and sharing news and photographs with you. At home you could enhance your child's learning by talking with your child about how we can improve our environment by recycling, disposing of litter carefully and making careful choices when shopping.

Making the most of every minute!

We monitor the amount of 'lates' in the registers. Juniors should arrive to school between 8.40 and 8.50.
