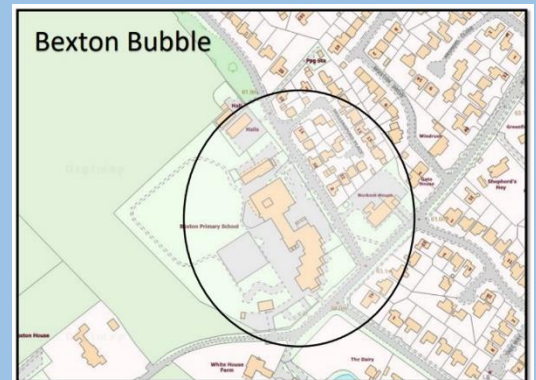
Need to know:
