**Free school meals:** The council provides two types of free school meals to children attending a school within Cheshire East. All infant children (reception to Year 2) are entitled to a free school meal. From Year 3 there is a means tested free school meal which is income related. If you receive Universal Credit with no earned income or with net monthly earnings less than £616.67 or receive Child Tax Credit and have a yearly household income less than £16,190 then your child/ren could be entitled to free school meals (including KS2 children). As a school, if your child is entitled to income related free school meals the government provides the school with some additional funding. We provide funded school trips and residentials and your child may get more classroom support from one of our teaching assistants. ## Every Day Counts:

It is vital that children attend school, on time, every day in order to gain the greatest benefit from their education. Have you ever arrived late to a meeting or the cinema? Take a minute to think about how that feels...like you don't know what's going on. This feeling is the same for a child who arrives late, even ten minutes. Their friends have begun their work and the child has to try and catch up.

We do monitor children's attendance and punctuality frequently and will be in touch with parents when it is in the 'worrying' section of this table. A reminder that Reception to Year 6 doors open at 8.40 with registers being taken at 8.50am.
