The School will:

- Not take holidays in term time.
- Inform school immediately if their child is absent.
- Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour.
- Support the ethos of the school.
- Support their child in homework in line with the Homework Policy.
- Attend Parents' Evening discussions about their child's progress.
- Check the homework diary at least once a week, make appropriate entries and sign.
