



Primary PE and sports premium 2023-2024: Funding plan

The government is continuing to provide additional funding for the academic year 2023/24 to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary schools. This funding is provided with the aim to:

- Develop or add to the P.E. and sport activities that school already offers
- Build capacity and capability within school to ensure that improvements now will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.

There are five key indicators that schools should expect to see improvements across:

- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity (the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend at least 60 minutes per day of which 30 minutes should be in school)
- The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
- Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching P.E. and sport
- Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- Increased participation in competitive sport.



Proposed spending for current academic year

2023-24	£20,100	Aim
KSSP	£1,375	To give all children an opportunity to compete against other children from the Knutsford Schools' Sports Partnership.
OPAL	£1,000	To build on our Platinum award by improving the school grounds in order to create happier playtimes, better play spaces and enable staff to support rich outdoor play and learning.
Rainbow Room	£5,000	Outdoor area complete with a playground and resources to support and enhance the physical development of our SEN children with complex needs, and to give them as much opportunity for play and learning as everyone else has.
Pupil Premium	£1,000	To support our pupil premium children and their families by enhancing their development and increasing their opportunities to access clubs before, during and after school, as well as trips.
Swimming pool package	£3,420	In the Autumn 2 half term, we will once again for the hire of a temporary outdoor pool. This will enable the school to provide catch up swimming sessions for the KS2 children who were affected by time out of school due to COVID-19 restrictions.
Resources – equipment and events	£1,500	Updating and adding to the P.E. equipment will allow more children to access all sports and more will have the opportunity to be involved and engaged before, during and after school. We will be able to expand Sports Day again this year, as well as complete whole school events and compete in local competitions.
Sale Sharks Rugby	Awaiting new quote	1 coach, half a day each week for a half term, who will deliver expert outdoor rugby lessons, whilst also covering a range of educational workshops; Mental Wellbeing, Healthy Lifestyles, Diet and Healthy Eating, Numeracy and Literacy. The children are also invited to participate in the North West Rugby Festival that Sale Sharks organise each year.
Cricket coaching	Awaiting new quote	Potential expert cricket coaching from Toft Cricket Club in 2024 to enhance the local community link and to boost cricket in Knutsford for girls and boys.
Tennis coaching	Awaiting new quote	Potential expert tennis coaching from Knutsford Tennis Club in 2024 to enhance the local community link and to boost tennis in Knutsford for girls and boys.
Athletes in Schools	Awaiting new quote	For Sports Week and the 2024 Paris Olympics. The UK's leading provider of inspirational Olympic / Paralympic athlete schools visits have been booked to provide the school with a whole school assembly and a full day of PE sessions for each year group.
Enrich Education	£2150	Outdoor Adventurous Activities and Orienteering curriculum for the whole school, including the return of their Quidditch event day.
