Uniform: As the new academic term begins, we'd like to give some gentle reminders about some key points from our uniform policy. Whilst we want the children to be comfortable and ready to learn, we do need to maintain high standards of presentation: Please make sure your child has:

- Clean black shoes to wear inside the school building.
- Spare trainers or wellies to wear outside. The trainers need to be in addition to the ones they would wear on a PE day.
- Some over-trousers to put over their uniform for playing outside. These can be jogging bottoms or waterproofs.
- Smart watches are not permitted to be worn in school due to their value and risk of external communications throughout

If children do not have suitable clothing for playing outside they will have to stay inside until these can be provided. We will inform parents by email if their child hasn't got something they need.
