This week's important information!

School Hours: A reminder that all classroom doors will open from 8.40am with the register being taken at 8.50am. The school day will end at 3.20pm for all children in the main school. Please ensure your child arrives promptly to maximize learning time each day. Nursery doors open at 9am and pick up is 3:00pm

<u>Medication</u>: A reminder to bring any medication your child needs in school and complete a new health form so we can continue to administer medication if needed. This **must** be done via the office.

<u>Clubs</u>: This half term's clubs will open for booking on Friday 6th September at 12pm for years 1-6. They will run from Monday 9th September until Friday 18th October. Please note some external clubs have a different start date – this is indicated on the form.

Meet the Teacher Session (Swans-Y6): A reminder that parents are invited to come and meet their child's teacher on Wednesday 11th September to find out more about what their child will be doing this year in school. There are two (repeated) sessions to allow you to visit more than one child's classroom. We will open the doors at 4.50pm to allow time for parents to find their way to the relevant room.

- 5.00-5.25 Session 1 (in your child's classroom)
- 5.30-5.55 Session 2 (in your child's classroom)

If you have only one child, we suggest you come to the second session. If you have a child who goes into the Rainbow Room with Mrs Kilshaw, they would love for you to visit their room for a tour and to meet the team. At 6pm there will be a short talk in the hall from the leadership team to share the school's priorities for the year and some information about our approach to Behaviour for Learning. We expect this to last approximately half an hour. Please note, this session is intended for parents/carers only.

PE Lessons 2024-2025: A reminder that children are wearing their PE kit on the day of their PE lessons. All children should be in the Bexton PE kit. If your child is attending a sports club after school, they should bring a change of clothing to school on that day.

Homework: Each week, on a Thursday, Years 1 - 6 will publish homework tasks to their class page on the school website. The homework may take the form of paper-based tasks, and/or via online platforms e.g. Spelling Shed and Times Tables Rock Stars. The homework should be completed by the following Tuesday. In Reception, homework will be published on Tapestry each Thursday and should be completed by the following Tuesday. The first homework of this academic year will be set next week on Thursday 12th September. Teachers will be able to provide more detailed information during the 'Meet the Teacher' evening next Wednesday.

School Dinners R-Y6: A reminder that school dinners can be chosen by the children each day during registration time and do not need to be booked in advance. Lunch choices can be found on the <u>website</u> and cost £2.80 per day for children Y3-6. Infant school dinners are free under the government Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) scheme. Please pay for school dinners via SCOPAY.
