Long Weekends!

Following our reminder about absence requests in the 13th September newsletter, we have now had our first external attendance review of the year. This review has already identified a trend in absences on Mondays and Fridays. While some of these absences are due to illness, we'd also like to remind you that extended weekend breaks involving a Monday or Friday (or both) will not be authorised—we often find out because the children can't help telling us where they've been on holiday! As we're still early in the term, I thought it would be helpful to remind you that we are required to issue Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) when a child has five days of unauthorised absence. There is increasing pressure from the government to reduce absences nationwide and we are committed to supporting this effort to ensure children are in school as much as possible.
