

Bexton Test Results 2022

The first table shows the percentage of Year 6 pupils at Bexton Primary School achieving each level, compared to national end of Key Stage 2 results. All results are test results, except writing which is teacher assessed. Progress for KS2 in reading, writing and maths is significantly above national averages.
